

Cookies policy

This Cookies Policy applies to our website www.hubshare.com, all branded pages on third party platforms (such as Facebook or YouTube) and applications accessed or used through such websites or third party platforms (our “Sites”), which are operated by or on behalf of Hubshare Solutions Limited (“we”, “us”, “our”).

BY USING OUR SITES YOU ARE CONSENTING TO OUR USE OF COOKIES IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS COOKIES POLICY.

WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a small text file stored by your web browser on your computer or mobile device. Some cookies are essential for our Sites to work and help us provide you with relevant information. They also allow us to recognise your computer (but not specifically who is using it) when you access our Sites and to improve the usability and performance of our Sites.

WHAT DO WE USE COOKIES FOR?

We use cookies to make our Sites easier to use and to better tailor the online experience to your interests and needs. Cookies may also be used to help speed up your future activities and experiences on our Sites. We also use cookies to compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that allow us to understand how people use our Sites and to help us improve their structure and content. We cannot identify you personally from this information.

Dependant on which of our Sites you access, we may use the following cookies:

Cookie Type	Purpose
Google Analytics _utma, _utmb, _utmc, _utmz	used to collect information about how you use our Sites
PHPSESSID	automatic session code generated by the system
Hubshare_cart	token of the shopping cart which allows the system to load the details from the database
Hubshare_currency	default currency defined by the user
Hubshare_culture	default culture defined by the user
Hubshare_login	if the users want to stay connected if they have closed their browser or sessions

DO WE USE THIRD PARTY COOKIES?

The only third party cookies which may be used on our Sites are those that track user interaction with our Sites in order for us to monitor traffic levels, user interaction and goal conversion. These cookies are used purely to help us improve the service we offer to our visitors and the information collected cannot and will not be used to identify individuals.

TURNING OFF AND DELETING COOKIES

You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. If you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Sites. Unless you have adjusted your browser settings so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you access our Sites. If you use different devices to view and access our Sites (for example, your computer, smart phone, tablet etc.) you will need to ensure that each browser on each device is adjusted to suit your cookie preferences.

If you disable the cookies that we use this may impact your experience while on our Sites.
